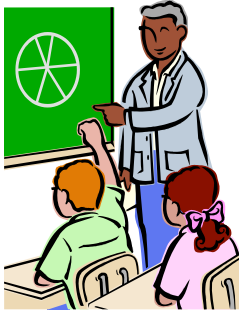


**She is Evelyn and she is a nurse.
